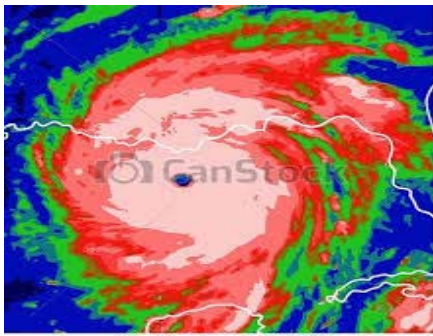




1-Day Seminar Procurement's Role When a Disaster Happens
