**ACHIEVEMENT AWARD PROGRAM**

**PURPOSE**

The Pennsylvania Public Purchasing Association (PAPPA), thirty-eighth Chapter of the National Institute of Governmental Purchasing, has established the Achievement Award Program for the primary purpose of recognizing those PAPPA members who have demonstrated significant contributions to the field of purchasing.

**ADMINISTRATION**

This program is administered by the PAPPA Awards and Scholarship Committee as established in the PAPPA By-Laws. The Awards and Scholarship Committee may choose to nominate to the Board of Directors, an individual for the Board to consider as a recipient of the Achievement Award. The Awards and Scholarship Committee shall submit to the Board, a one-page essay that contains the contributions the nominee has made over the years as a PAPPA member, to assist the Board in its review.

**QUALIFICATIONS**

An individual who has been a member in good standing, taking into consideration the number of years he/she has been a PAPPA member, his/her attendance records at PAPPA functions/events and the level of participation and volunteering he/she has performed.

**AWARDS**

Achievement Awards shall be as follows:

- An engraved PAPPA watch, plaque and a \$100 gift certificate.

**AWARDS CEREMONY**

- Award(s) will be presented at a time and place designated by the Board of Directors.
